

DIY Buckskin Halloween Costume!

Supplies: Fleece or knit fabric (2 times child's height)

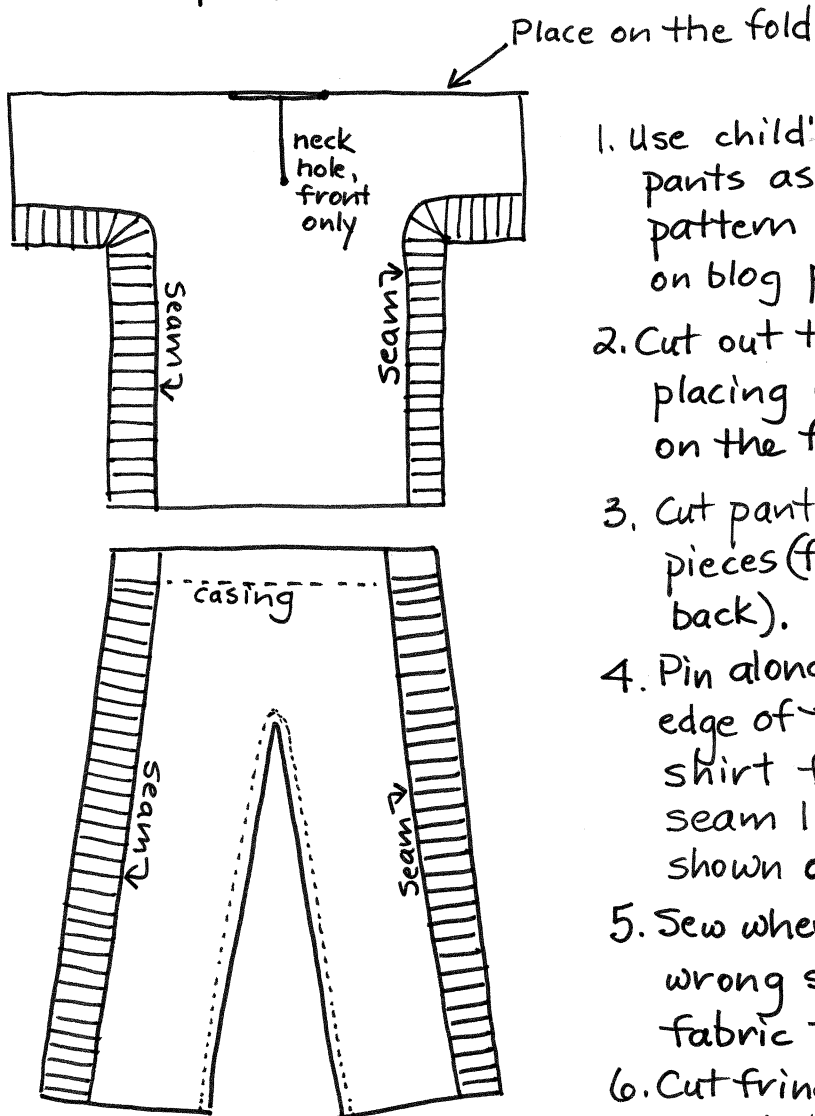
Thread

Scissors

3/4" elastic

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1. Use child's shirt & pants as the pattern as shown on blog post.
2. Cut out the top placing upper edge on the fold.
3. Cut pants - 2 pieces (for front & back).
4. Pin along the edge of pants & shirt for a seam line as shown on blog post.
5. Sew where pinned, wrong sides of fabric together.
6. Cut fringe, don't cut through seams.
7. Turn pants inside out & sew a one inch casing along the top. Run the elastic through the casing.

8. Sew inner leg seam with 1/2 inch seam.
9. Cut neck hole along folded edge of top, cut a short slit down front (only large enough for head).
